





## We Value Your Privacy

National Western Life values its relationship with you. Protecting the privacy of information we have about you is of great importance to us. We want you to understand how we protect the confidentiality and security of that information, as well as how and why we use and disclose it.

This is being provided to you to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018.

## Information We Collect

For the purpose of providing insurance products, we collect information that identifies, relates to, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with you ("personal information"). In particular, we collect and have collected the following information within the past twelve months:

- Category: Identifiers. This includes names, aliases, postal addresses, unique personal identifiers, online identifiers, Internet Protocol addresses, email addresses, account names and numbers (including bank account numbers, credit card numbers, and debit card numbers), social security numbers, driver's license numbers, passport numbers, and California identity card numbers. This information will be used to potentially contract with you and appoint you as an agent.
- Category: Individual information. This includes telephone numbers, financial information, age, citizenship, character, general reputation, mode of living, sex (including gender), creditworthiness, commission related debt balance information, and credit history. This information will be used to potentially contract with you and appoint you as an agent.
- Category: Information provided by you. This includes information on your agent data sheet and other forms.
   This information will be used to potentially contract with you and appoint you as an agent.
- Category: Information about your transactions with us. This includes policy coverage, premium, your balance(s), and payment history. This information will be used to service your contract.

Note: Personal information does not include:

- Publicly available information from government records.
- De-identified or aggregated consumer information.
- Information excluded from the CCPA's scope, like:
  - Health or medical information covered by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996
     (HIPAA) and the California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act (CMIA) or clinical trial data;
  - Personal information covered by certain sector-specific privacy laws, including the Fair Credit Reporting
    Act (FRCA), the Gramm- Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) or California Financial Information Privacy Act (FIPA), and
    the Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994.
